Discipleship is a widely-used word to describe a journey of spiritual growth.

Christian discipleship is the process of making someone become like Christ.



It refers to imitating the teacher's life, inculcating His value and reproducing His teachings.

The Greek word for disciple, "mathetes," means pupil, learner, schoolboy, student, apprentice...

Thus, a disciple is a learner who follows a masterteacher.

The cost of discipleship is denying self, taking up selfcross daily and following Jesus.

Apostleship is the gift that instills missionary zeal in those who are sent out to preach the Gospel message to the unreached.

Greek word "apostolos," means one who is sent out or "person sent." It applied to any of the 12 disciples chosen by Jesus Christ and Paul.

Today, we shall focus on how to be a disciple and apostle of Christ to make a home, entering into newness.
