PASTOR'S CORNER

THE SCOURGE OF MENTAL AND EMOTIONAL ILL-HEATH IN OUR SOCIETY – THE CHRISTIAN RESPONSE.

Being in a good mental state can keep you healthy and prevent some serious health conditions. The Word of God says "Beloved, I pray that you may prosper in all things and be in health, just as your soul prospers" (3 John 2). Despite the fact that Apostle John had said '...prosper in ALL things...' which included health, he still singled out health out of ALL things. This suggests to me that the importance of being in good health cannot be overemphasized.

As we have heard several times, health is not just mere absence of disease or infirmity but a state of complete physical, social and mental well-being. Mental health affects your mood, thoughts and behaviour. Poor mental health can lead to poor physical health or harmful behaviours. The World Health Organization (WHO) estimates that a whopping 20% of Nigerians, around 40 million people are affected by mental illness.

The greatest antidote to mental and emotional Ill-heath irrespective of the cause is the Word of God. Fill your heart with the Word of God and meditate in it. It takes over your thought. Jesus said "In this world you will have trouble. But take heart! I have overcome the world" (John 16:33). 1 Corinthians 10:13 says "No temptation has overtaken you except what is common to mankind. And God is faithful; He will not let you be tempted beyond what you can bear. But when you are tempted, He will also provide a way out so that you can endure it." There is always a way out. JESUS IS THE WAY.
