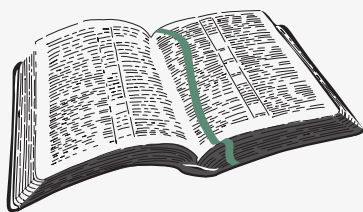

KINGDOM RIGHTEOUSNESS

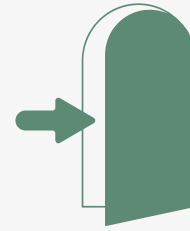

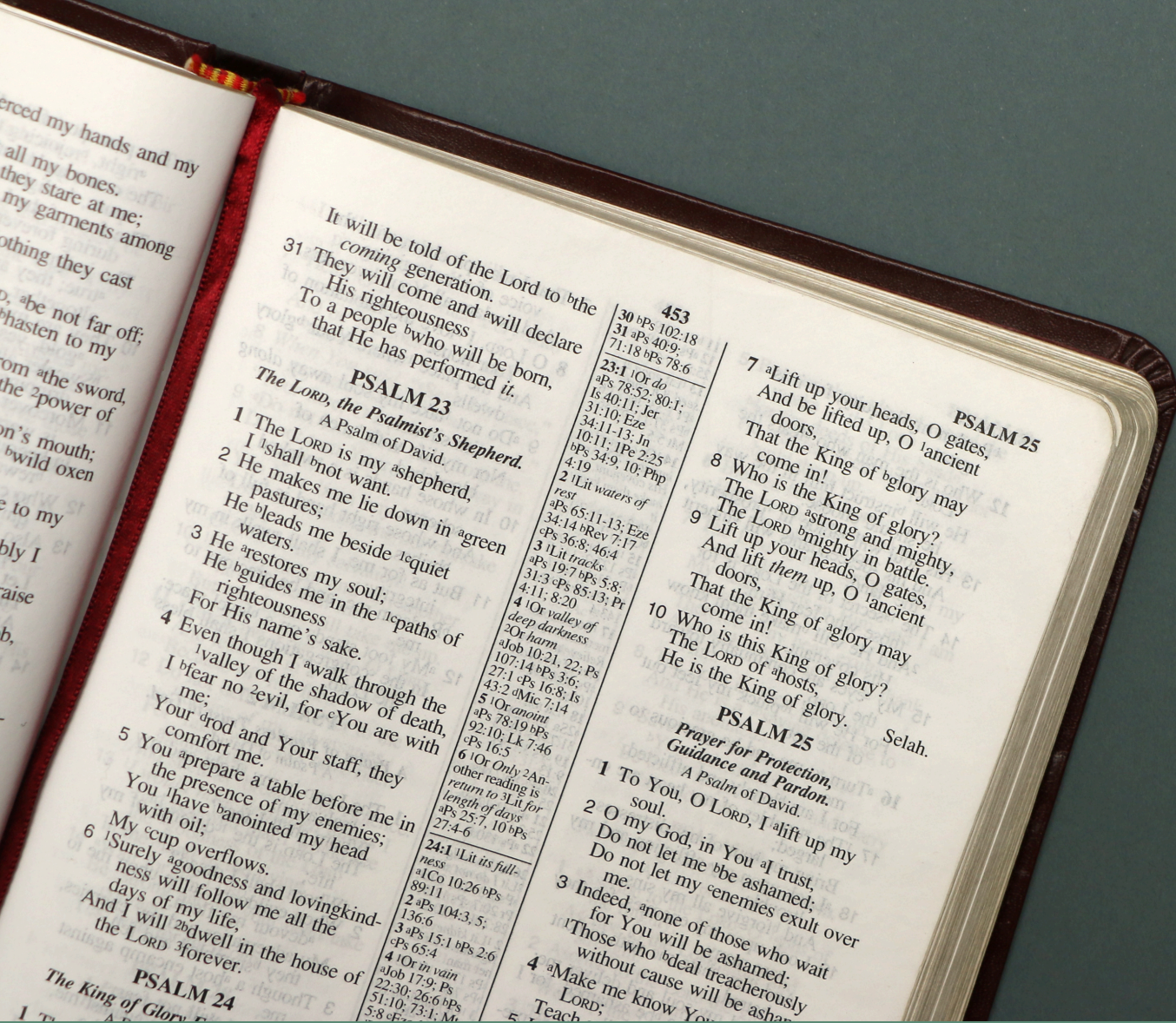
