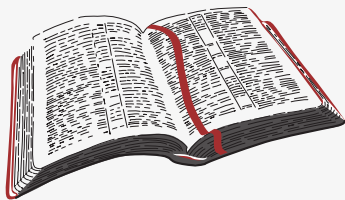

THE BORN KING

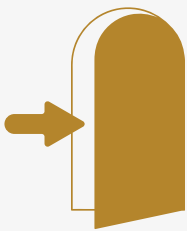
