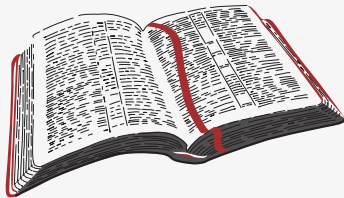

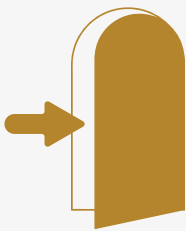
# PRAISE THE BORN KING
