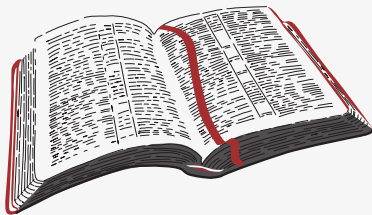

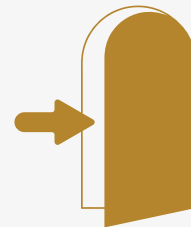
May God of glory keep us rising and shining together and not alone in Jesus' name.
