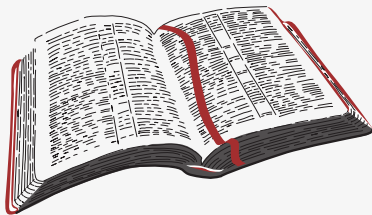

Brethren, appreciation is an application. You are appreciated for appreciating values and virtues.

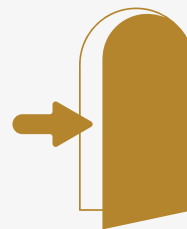
Therefore, let appreciation add more blessings and bonding in your relationship. May the spirit of appreciation fill our homes in Jesus' name.
