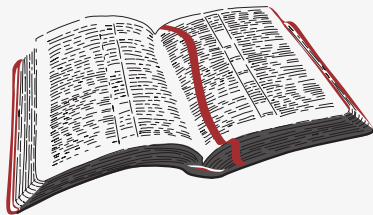

LIFESTYLE MEDICINE: LIVING GOD'S DREAM FOR OUR HEALTH.

"Dear friend, I pray that you may enjoy good health and that all may go well with you, even as your soul is getting along well." 3 John 2.

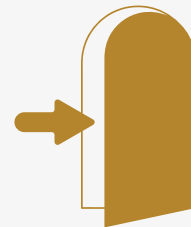
May we all live long and live well to fulfill God's purpose for our lives. Amen.
